Oil Search included in Dow Jones Sustainability Australia Index for third successive year

Oil Search's sustainability performance has once again been recognised, with its inclusion in the 2015 Dow Jones Sustainability™ Australia Index for the third year in a row.

[The Dow Jones Sustainability Indices](#) are maintained by [S&P Dow Jones Indices](#) and [RobecoSAM](#). The indices measure the performance of the world's sustainability leaders and are widely used by investors. Companies are selected for the indices based on a comprehensive assessment of long-term economic, environmental and social criteria that account for general as well as industry-specific sustainability trends. Only firms that lead their industries based on this assessment are included in the indices.

Of the 12 oil and gas companies invited to participate in the Australia Index, Oil Search is one of only four to be included

Oil Search beat the global industry average score in 21 of the 23 categories and recorded global-best industry scores for two - 'gas portfolio' and 'payment transparency'. Outstanding scores were also received for 'releases to the environment' and 'labour practices and human rights'.

"We're delighted to be included again in the Dow Jones Sustainability Australia Index," said Gereia Aopi, Executive General Manager, External Affairs and Sustainability. "Oil Search's inclusion is a welcome acknowledgement from the investment community of our achievements as a socially responsible operator."
